Message from Our CEO

Welcome to the second Entrepreneurs' Forum Impact Report.

When I look back at 2025, I am struck by the resilience, creativity and determination of our members. The Entrepreneurs' Forum exists to support these people - the individuals who take risks, create jobs and drive growth across the North East and beyond. Our mission is simple but ambitious: to be the number one support organisation for entrepreneurs in the UK. This year has reminded me why ambition matters so much.

The life of an entrepreneur is never easy. In 2025, our members faced rising costs, challenging government policies, skills shortages and uncertainty in the markets. Confidence was damaged by the Autumn budget, yet despite these challenges, our community of North East based entrepreneurs collectively generated turnover of £2.5 billion, up from £2.2 billion in the previous year. Together, they employed 16,000 staff.

Our quarterly pulse survey confirms our members have ambitious growth plans, with two thirds planning revenue increases in the next 12 months. Most can see opportunities to grow market share in their existing markets, whilst nearly half intend to introduce new products or services in the coming year.

International operations have been challenging with introductions of tariffs causing uncertainty. Yet despite this, our

members sought solutions. Take Victoria Lynch, founder of Stockton based Additional Lengths, who's shifted market focus from the US to Europe, Australia and the Middle East.

However, the numbers only tell part of the story. What excites me most is seeing the way our members support each other when given the opportunity. Our events programme is designed to create the environment where ideas and challenges can be shared openly and honestly. This year alone, we brokered nearly 100 mentoring connections, and provided over 4500 hours of education via our learning workshops. Time and time again, members tell us that these moments of connection are the inspiration that helps them move forwards with confidence.

Looking ahead, our ambition remains to be the leading support organisation for entrepreneurs in the UK, supporting the entrepreneur, not just the business. This means continuing to raise the bar on the quality of our events and programmes and investing in the insights and data which demonstrate the impact we have.

None of this would be possible without our members, partners and supporters. I am deeply grateful for the trust you place in the Entrepreneurs' Forum. As you read this report, I hope you take pride in what we have achieved in 2025 and feel inspired, as I do, about what lies ahead.

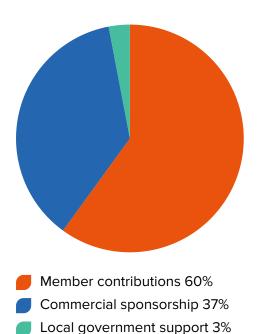
Who We Are

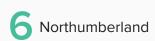

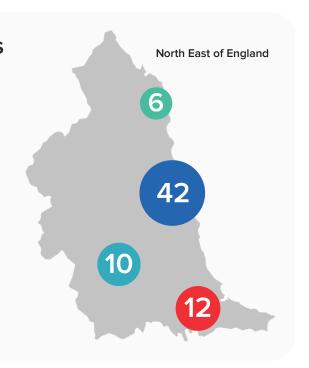

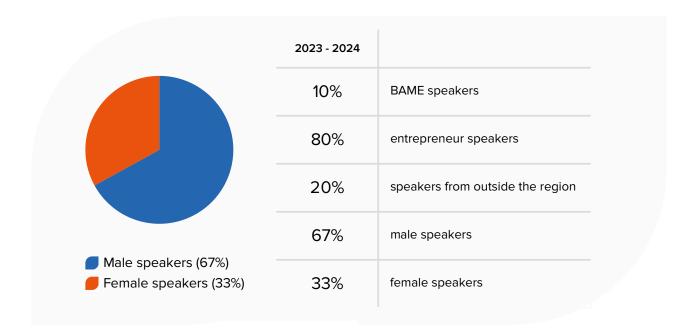
Year in Review: Our Speakers

Learning: Scale-up Leaders' Academy

Our Scale-up Leaders' Academy is our flagship leadership course, designed for entrepreneurs who want to scale their organisations. Run annually, over six months, the programme delivers practical learning to founders to allow them to position their business for high growth.

Launched in 2017, the Academy is backed by the UK ScaleUp Institute as a "One to Watch" programme. Previous alumni include Jo Feeley (Trend Bible), Richard Lane (durhamlane), Raman Seghal (ramarketing), Steve Rawlingson (Samuel Knight), Emma Gaudern (EMG Solicitors), Chloe Clover (Wander Films) and Danny Wade (Wade Construction Management).

2017-2024 impact:

- 67 entrepreneurs completed the programme
- Average growth in employees since completion of the programme = +17
- Average growth in balance sheet since completion of the programme = +137%
- 10 founders have raised external finance totalling approximately £8 million
- 3 founders have successfully exited, two of which have gone on to create new businesses

Beyond the Forum

Our Environment

We are committed to operating sustainably and where possible we minimise our impact on the environment.

- Our member magazine is printed on paper sourced from suppliers certified by the Forest Stewardship Council ® (FSC®) and the Programme for Endorsement of Forest Certification (PEFC). These certifications ensure that the paper used originates from responsibly managed forests and other controlled sources that comply with strict environmental, social, and economic standards. The ink used is made using vegetable oils and colorants, a more eco-friendly alternative to traditional petroleumbased inks.
- To minimise miles travelled to our events, we promote the use of public transport and car sharing where possible, including for speakers who travelled from outside of the region to our events.
- We work with each of our event venues to minimise our carbon footprint, as well as plastic and food waste.

Our Supply Chain

We make every effort to use North East suppliers. In the year ending March 2025, over 92% of our suppliers were based locally, with the final 8% being UK National or overseas.







We are a not-for-profit membership organisation.

Our Board of Directors are all experienced entrepreneurs who meet quarterly to guide our strategic direction and champion our mission: to make the North East an outstanding place to start and grow a business.
